**8. Any Other Business**

Mrs. Platts advised that she was approached by a member of public in regards to 'Passing Place' signs on Common Road, as there are none, but there are on Ellerker Road. This matter is to be brought up on the Village Taskforce Walkabout, all agreed.

Mrs Shipley asked if putting a Dog Poo bag dispenser at the start of the track at the side of the Village Hall, would encourage irresponsible dog owners to pick up their dog mess, as it is a disgrace and now avoided for walking her dogs. It was agreed that it would not help as if owners do not pick up after their dogs, bags would not improve the situation. However if evidence can be provided as to who the culprits are, the Dog Warden will be informed accordingly.

Mr Copley advised that the Slide equipment has been broken and is now out of use. Mr Harper said that he had some more marine ply which was used last time to make other repairs if we needed it FOC. Mr Harper asked Mr Platts if he would help with repairs again. Mr Platts agreed to help and will liaise with Mr Harper to complete repairs. Mr Gibbons said that he had some none slip water resistant paint still left for when needed.

Ms. Hall advised that last time Carr lane crossings were closed, the signage was not clear, and caused confusion to a lot of people. Ms. Hall asked if we could ask for an additional sign to be placed at the bottom of Wallingfen lane so commuters do not have to get all the way to the crossings before that are aware especially when they are not residents of Broomfleet. Mrs. Shipley advised that new signage has been put at the crossings and the information is clearer to understand. Clerk to ask ERYC if an additional sign is possible.
